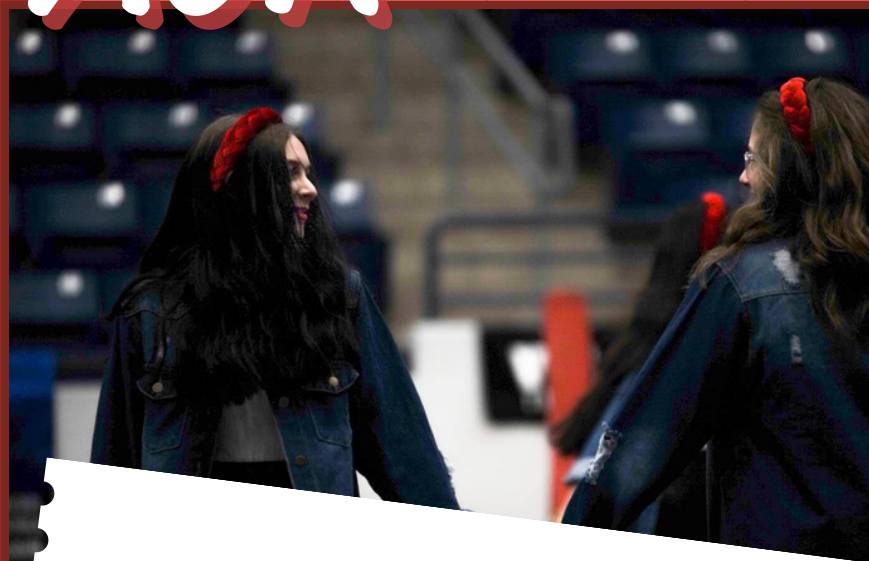
Indoor Etiquette
